A community survey of Mooresburg residents was conducted 2014-15.

22% of our neighbors stated they did not have enough food to last a month.

24% were not able to pay their bills without hardship.

84% would like to see better access to medical facilities.

87% would like to see more programs for children

84% have concerns about drug abuse

86% would like to see more services for seniors

Over the past year, October 2014-September 2015, The Mooresburg Community Association has increased:

Our in house food pantry **added** 99 families, 192 household members to our census

We provided 113 medical transports for area residents

Our Meals in the Hills program **added** 51 new individuals to receive up to 7 meals per week

Our Feeding America Mobile Food Pantry Truck **added** 199 families and 494 Household members
